Adoptive Family Information



The Adopt-a-Student Program is new this fall. Our goal is to connect active and interested students with active and interested “families” in the congregation. A family can be an individual, a nuclear family, a couple, a single parent and children, or several unrelated individuals who agree to work together in supporting their student. If your “family” is not all living at the same house, please fill out two forms and staple them together before turning them in.

### Responsibilities of Adoptive Families:

- \*Meet and get to know your student.
- \*Greet your student on Sundays that they attend church or at any other church activity
- \*Contact/support your student at least once a month (see ideas below)
- \*Pray regularly for your student
- \*Enjoy the fellowship of knowing and supporting a special student

### Support Activity Ideas (just one a month – you don’t have to do all of them!)

- \*Call, e-mail or snail mail a greeting
- \*Take the student to an activity/event at church or in the community
- \* Invite the student to your home for a meal
- \*Drop off homemade cookies, bread, or a meal for your student
- \*Include the student in a family outing – ballgame, museum, movie, dinner out
- \*Offer rides to church or church activities
- \*Prepare a care package to get the student through finals week
- \*Attend the student’s activities (ball game, concert, show) at the university
- \*Honor the student’s birthday with a card or a small gift or a special meal.

Adoptive Families will be assigned after the students return in the fall. The assignment will last for a year (particularly through the school year – May) although the friendship may last a lifetime.
